## Skills:

## Personality:

You are the diamond of the night. You gain 2 dots in Wits and 2 dots in Presence. Your tongue is your weapon of choice and people just seem to gravitate towards you. Being the Gossip makes you someone fun for conversation at any event.

## Standing:

As the Gossip of the Family, they find you a bit silly and not serious. As such, you start at a Standing 2 in the Family. You have less sway over Family matters and the Family never turns to you for advice. Perhaps if you rise in Standing, the Family may favor you more. Or perhaps, you will fall from grace and give them a good reason for never trusting you.

## Accomplishments:

This is a list of accomplishments that you can take as the Gossip. A few are personal to your trope, but you may take any three. If you find that a skill you want isn't listed, speak with your Author about making yourself a new skill.
